Included in the policy
<p>Vet Fees</p> <p>The amount we will pay towards veterinary fees each year. When you renew your policy the full benefit you've chosen is reinstated. Up to £6,500 / £12,500, 0% / 10% / 20% variable excess, £85 / £150 fixed excess per condition per year</p>
<p>Advertising</p> <p>Help towards finding your lost or stolen dog including the cost of advertising and offering a reward. Up to £1,000 / £1,500, 0% variable excess, £0 fixed excess per condition per year</p>
<p>Third Party Liability</p> <p>Third Party Liability provides cover for bodily injury where you are liable and cover for damage to property where you are liable up to £2,000,000 / £3,000,000, 0% variable excess, £250 fixed excess per condition per year</p>
<p>Travel expenses and accommodation if your vet refers your dog to another vet for treatment.</p> <p>Up to £300 each year</p>
Optional Benefits - you choose
<p>Death benefit</p> <p>You will not be covered for any amount if your dog is lost, stolen or strays within 10 days of the policy start date. Up to £1,500 / £2,500, 0% variable excess, £0 fixed excess per condition per year</p>
<p>Boarding Fees</p> <p>Holiday cancellation and boarding fees / daily minding fees. Up to £1,000 / £2,000, 0% variable excess, £0 fixed excess per condition per year</p>
<p>Breeding risks You will not be covered for any amount if your dog is under the age of 1 years old at the time of whelping or within the 1st 12 weeks of the policy start date.</p> <p>Includes:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fertility examination and associated veterinary treatment, plus vet's fees for complications from gestation and while giving birth including caesarean section and fading puppies (up to £1,000 each year). • Vet's fees pre-sale or up to 14 weeks of age whichever is sooner (up to £1,000 each year).
